ORDINANCE NO.03-08-04-90

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE USE OF GROUNDWATER AS A PORTABLE WATER SUPPLY BY THE INSTALLATION OR USE OF PORTABLE WATER SUPPLY WELLS OR BY ANY OTHER METHOD

WHEREAS, certain properties in the City of LeRoy, McLean County, Illinois have been used over a period of time for commercial/industrial purposes; and

WHEREAS, because of said use, concentrations of certain chemical constituents in the groundwater beneath the City may exceed Class I groundwater quality standards for potable resource groundwater as set forth in 35 Illinois Administrative Code 620 or Tier 1 residential remediation objectives as set forth in 35 Illinois Administrative Code 742; and

WHEREAS, the City of LeRoy desires to limit potential threats to human health from groundwater contamination while facilitating the redevelopment and productive use of properties that are the source of said chemical constituents;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of LeRoy, McLean County, Illinois:

Section One. Use of groundwater as a potable water supply prohibited.

The use or attempt to use as a potable water supply groundwater from within the corporate limits of the City of LeRoy in any area serviceable by City water by the installation or drilling of wells by connecting water supply from a well to a source of portable water or by any other method is hereby prohibited.

Section Two. Penalties.

Any person violating the provisions of this ordinance shall be subject to a fine of up to \$100.00 for each violation. A separate violation shall be deemed committed every day such groundwater is connected to a potable water supply.

Section Three. Definitions.

"Person" is any individual, partnership, co-partnership, firm, company, limited liability company, corporation, association, joint stock company, trust, estate, political subdivision, or any other legal entity, or their legal representatives, agents or assigns.

"Potable water" is any water used for human or domestic consumption, including, but not limited to, water used for drinking, bathing, swimming, washing dishes or preparing foods.

Section Four. Repealer.

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed insofar as they are in conflict with this ordinance.

Section Five. Severability.

If any provision of this ordinance or its application to any person or under any circumstances is adjudged invalid, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole or of any portion not adjudged invalid.

Section Six. Effective date.
