ORDINANCE NO. 149

AN ORDINANCE AMMENDING THE MUNICIPLE CODE, LE ROY, ILLINOIS, 1975 CHAPTER 6, WATER SERVICE, ADDITION OF NEW SECTIONS.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE MUNICIPAL CODE, LE ROY, ILLINOIS, 1975, CHAPTER 6, WATER SERVICE, ADDITION OF NEW SECTIONS.

Whereas, the Mayor and City Council of the City of LeRoy, Illinois, have determined it to be in the best interests of the public to provide for the discontinuation of water service in certain instances where particular users of the city water service violate the ordinances and rules regulating the use and provision of such service, and

Whereas, the present city ordinances provide for the discontinuation of water service to premises of persons violating the rules and regulations concerning city water service, and

Whereas, the Mayor and City Council of the City of LeRoy have determined that further definition and regulation as to the discontinuation of such service is in the best interests of the city,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of LeRoy, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter 6, Water Service, is hereby amended by adding thereto new Section 6.27 to read:

"DISCONTINUANCE OF SERVICE: The City of LeRoy reserves the right to discontinue service for any one or more of the following reasons or conditions:

- (a) Unauthorized use of or tampering with any curb stop, meter, meter seal or other property of the city water department. Evidence of a broken meter seal or the insertion of a by-pass or other connection which could be used for the purpose of obtaining unmetered water shall constitute sufficient evidence to justify discontinuation of service in such instance.
- (b) Non-payment for service rendered to the customer.
- (c) The existence of any piping cross-connection with any other source of supplier apparatus which may endanger the quality of the city's water supply.
- (d) Refusal of reasonable access to the premises for the purpose of inspecting, reading, repairing or removal of a meter.
- (e) Failure to repair any defect or leak in a service pipe within five (5) days after discovery."

<u>Section 2</u>. That Chapter 6, Water Service, is hereby further amended by adding thereto new Section 6.28 to read as follows:

"RESTORATION OR RECONNECTION OF SERVICE AND PAYMENT FOR ESTIMATED USE OF WATER: In any instance where evidence of a broken meter seal, unauthorized use of or tampering with a curb stop, meter, meter seal or other property of the water department, or the insertion of a by-pass or other connection for the apparent purpose of obtaining unmetered water is discovered, the customer shall pay the city for the estimated quantity of water delivered and not registered, plus the cost to restore the meter to proper working order and any other expense necessitated to correct or repair any damage resulting from such unauthorized use of or tampering with any curb stop, meter, meter seal or other property of the city water department. Restoration or reconnection of water service will be made only after all such fees as well as any delinquent water charges have been paid."

Section 3. That this ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as required by law.
