ORDINANCE NO.02-10-03-10

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 3, CITY ADMINISTRATION, OF THE CITY OF LE ROY MUNICIPAL CODE, BY ADDING NEW SECTION 3.16 "PAYMENT OF BILLS"

Whereas, the Mayor and the City Council of the City of Le Roy have determined that for the sake of administrative efficiency and fiscal security it is desirable that provisions be made as to the manner of approval and payment of all invoices and sums due for payment by the City, and

Whereas, certain insurers involved with the City have recommended that a system of countersignature be adopted with regard to payment of sums due for payment by the City; and

Whereas, the Mayor and the City Council of the City of Le Roy recognize the necessity of establishing internal controls that comport with sound fiscal management with regard to the payment of sums due for payment by the City; and

Whereas, Section 8-1-8 of the Illinois Municipal Code (65 ILCS 5/8-1-8) requires that all warrants drawn upon the municipal treasury must be signed by the mayor and countersigned by the municipal clerk, stating the particular fund to which the warrant is chargeable, and the person to whom payable,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LE ROY, ILLINOIS:

<u>Section One</u>: New Section 3.16, "PAYMENT OF BILLS", of Chapter 3, City Administration, of the Municipal Code of the City of Le Roy, Illinois, 1975, as amended, is hereby adopted in words and figures as follows:

- (a) The City Clerk shall prepare, immediately preceding each regular meeting of the City Council, a warrant on the City Treasury for the payment of all sums then due form the City, listing each individual sum and the fund out of which it is payable and the person or entity to which it is payable. The warrant may contain one or more sums then due and may in the form of a computer generated document.
- (b) Approval of such list of individual sums to be paid by the Council on a roll call vote shall constitute the Council's approval of all the expenses listed thereon; except any warrant restricted in the original motion.
- (c) Upon approval by the Council of the warrant, the City Clerk and the Mayor shall each sign the warrant to authorize the issuance of a voucher or check as provided by law for the payment of each listed sum.
- (d) Each voucher or check shall be signed by the City Treasurer, or if unavailable, the Assistant City Treasurer. Each voucher or check shall also be signed by at least one of the following persons: the Mayor, the City Clerk, or any member of the City Council.

<u>Section Two</u>: Except as provided herein, the Municipal Code of the City of Le Roy, Illinois, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect

<u>Section Three</u>: The City Clerk is hereby authorized to publish this ordinance in pamphlet form as provided by law.

<u>Section Four</u>: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the passage, approval and publication, as required by law.
