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Whereas, the results of the 2000 decennial census taken in Le Roy, Illinois, showed that the City of Le Roy had 3332 inhabitants, and such population figure has been certified by the Secretary of State of Illinois; and

Whereas, under Section 3.1-20-10 of the Illinois Municipal Code (65 ILCS 5/3.1-20-10), the City would be entitled, by reason of its population, to eight aldermen; and

Whereas, Sections 3.1-20-15 and 3.1-20-25 of the Illinois Municipal Code (65 ILCS 5/3.1-20-15 and 65 ILCS 5/3.1-20-25) require the Le Roy City Council, from time to time, to divide the City into the number of wards to which the City is entitled, requiring the wards to be as nearly equal in population, and the wards to be of as compact and contiguous territory, as practicable, with the additional requirement that such wards be created in such a manner so that no voting precinct shall be divided between two or more wards, insofar as is practicable; and

Whereas, the United States Constitution requires wards to be divided so that the population of each ward is a near equal as practicable,

### NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LE ROY, ILLINOIS:

<u>Section One</u>: Chapter 2, City Council, Section 2.01 of the Municipal Code of the City of Le Roy, Illinois, 1975, as amended, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

2.01 WARDS. The City of Le Roy shall be divided into four wards, to be known as the First, Second, Third and Fourth Wards, the boundaries of which shall be as follows:

WARD 1. Beginning at the Northeast corner of the corporation limits, thence south along the corporation limits to the center line of East Washington Street, thence west along the center line of Washington Street to the intersection of the center lines of Washington and Lynn Streets, thence north to the intersection of the center lines of Lynn and Warren Streets, thence west along the center line of Warren Street to the corporation limits, thence north along the corporation limits to the Northwest corner of the corporation limits, thence east along the corporation limits to the point of beginning.

WARD 2. Beginning at the center line of East Washington Street and

the corporation limits, thence south along the corporation limits to the center line of East Cherry Street extended to the corporation limits, thence west along the center line of Cherry Street extended to the corporation limits, thence north along the corporation limits to the intersection of the center line of Warren Street, thence east along the center line of Warren Street to the intersection of the center lines of Warren and Lynn Streets, thence south along the center line of Lynn Street to the intersection of the center lines of Lynn and Washington Streets, thence east along the center line of Washington Street to the point of beginning.

WARD 3. Beginning at the center line of East Cherry Street extended to the corporation limits, thence south and east along the corporation limits to the intersection of the center line of East Street, thence south along the corporation limits to the intersection with the Interstate 74 right-of-way, thence north and west along the Interstate 74 right-of-way to the intersection of the center line of Chestnut Street, thence north along the center line of Chestnut Street to the intersection of the center lines of Chestnut and Vine Streets, thence west along the center line of Vine Street to the corporation limits, thence north along the corporation limits to the intersection of the corporation limits and Cherry Street extended to the corporation limits, thence east along the center line of Cherry Street extended to the point of beginning.

WARD 4. Beginning at the intersection of the center line of County Highway 21 and the southeastern most point of the corporation limits, thence west and north along the corporation limits to the center line of Vine Street, thence east to the intersection of the center lines of Vine and Chestnut Streets, thence south to the intersection of Chestnut Street and the Interstate 74 right-of-way, thence east along the Interstate 74 right-of-way to the center line of East Street, thence south along the center line of East Street extended to the intersection of the center lines of East Street and County Highway 21, thence east and south along the corporation limits to the point of the beginning.

<u>Section Two</u>: Chapter 2, City Council, Section 2.05 of the Municipal Code of the City of Le Roy, Illinois, 1975, as amended, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

2.05 TERMS OF OFFICE. The Mayor and Aldermen shall be elected to terms of 4 years and until their successors are elected and qualified. The number of Aldermen shall consist of eight; two elected from each ward. Newly elected officers shall take office at the first regular or special meeting held in the first month succeeding the month in which the election for office is held.

<u>Section Three</u>: Except as provided herein, the Municipal Code of the City of Le Roy, Illinois, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.

<u>Section Four</u>: The City Clerk is hereby authorized to publish this ordinance in pamphlet form as provided by law.

<u>Section Five</u>: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication, as required by law.
