ORDINANCE NO. 700

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING SALE OR DELIVERY OF ALCOHOLIC LIQUORS IN A BUILDING AND ON PREMISES OWNED BY THE CITY OF LEROY

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council of the City of LeRoy, McLean County, Illinois, an Illinois municipal corporation, have determined that it is in the best interests of the City and its residents that the sale and delivery of alcoholic liquors be approved in a building and on premises owned by the City of LeRoy,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the City Council of the City of LeRoy, McLean County, Illinois, in lawful meeting assembled, as follows:

- <u>Section 1</u>. The sale and delivery of alcoholic liquors in a building and on premises located at 202 East Pine Street, LeRoy, Illinois, belonging to the City of LeRoy is hereby approved subject to the city liquor control ordinance, being Chapter 34 of the Municipal Code of the City of LeRoy, McLean County, Illinois, 1975 (as amended).
- <u>Section 2</u>. All ordinances, or parts thereof, and all resolutions, or parts thereof, in conflict with this ordinance shall be and the same are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict, and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect as set forth hereafter.
- Section 3. Nothing in this ordinance hereby adopted shall be construed to affect any suit or proceeding pending in any court, or any rights acquired, or any liability incurred, or any cause or causes of action acquired or existing, under any act or ordinance hereby repealed as cited in Section 2 of this ordinance; nor shall any just or legal right or remedy of any character be lost, impaired or affected by this ordinance.
- <u>Section 4</u>. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form, as required by law.
