ORDINANCE NO. 02-07-02-80

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR AND APPROVING THE SALE OF PERSONAL PROPERTY OF THE CITY OF LE ROY, McLEAN COUNTY, ILLINOIS

WHEREAS, the City of Le Roy, being organized under the laws of the State of Illinois and having less than 500,000 population, owns personal property which in the opinion of a simple majority of the corporate authorities now holding office is no longer necessary or useful to, or for, the best interests of said City; and

WHEREAS, a majority of the corporate authorities now holding office at a regular meeting held at 7:00 p.m., on July 15th, 2002, did make and aforesaid determination;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the City Council of the City of Le Roy, Illinois, in lawful meeting assembled:

Section 1. The 1971 Chevrolet MODEL G10 van with Vehicle Identification Number GS151U138512 and the 1993 Chevrolet Caprice 4 door police vehicle with Vehicle Identification Number 1G1BL537PW1429176 be sold by the City of Le Roy as follows: the City Clerk shall place an ad in the Le Roy Journal advertising said personal property for sale and requesting sealed bids be delivered to the City Clerk by 2:00 p.m on Friday, August 16, 2002 at which time said bids shall be opened. Final bids will be delivered to the City Council at their regular meeting to be held on Monday, August 19, 2002. The City Council may reject all bids or may declare the item sold to the highest responsive bidder. The property shall be turned over to the successful bidder upon payment in full of the purchase price. Before offering said vehicle for sale, appropriate city officials shall cause all police equipment, including police lights, siren, cage, and two-way radio to be removed from the vehicle.

Section 2. That such sale is hereby ratified effective the date of sale, August 19, 2002.

Section 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as required by law.
