SUPPLEMENTAL ANNUAL APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE NO. 170
FOR THE CITY OF LE ROY, ILLINOIS
1982 - 1983

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council of the City of LeRoy, McLean County, Illinois, an Illinois municipal corporation, have determined that it is in the best interests of said city to purchase a sewer cleaning machine and a root cutting machine described as follows:

Sewer cleaning machine - 1972 Peabody Myers Model 800 Vector,
Myers Cherman Company

Root cutting machine - Model J 1601 O'Brien 3/4",

made available by Sewer Jet, Inc. of Illinois and Missouri, for use in the maintenance and upkeep of the city sewer system; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council of the City of LeRoy, McLean County, Illinois, have determined that additional revenues of the city will be made available to purchase said equipment;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of LeRoy, McLean County, Illinois, in lawful meeting assembled, as follows:

Section 1. That the ANNUAL APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE NO. 162 FOR THE CITY OF LE ROY, ILLINOIS, 1982 - 1983, making appropriations for corporate purposes for the fiscal year beginning May 1, 1982, and ending April 30, 1983, is amended by adding the following under Section V Sewer Department, Subsection B "Other":

"Purchase of sewer cleaning machine (\$32,000.00) and root cutting machine (\$1,602.05)\$33,602.05",

said appropriation to be received from tax levy.

Section 2. That the total appropriation under Section V, to B "Other", is hereby amended from \$183,000.00 to \$216,612.05, and that the total appropriation for the Sewer Department is hereby amended from \$286,109.00 to \$319,711.05 and that appropriation for the expenses of the Sewer Department is hereby amended to include a third line of source of revenue, that being as follows:

"Appropriated for the foregoing expenses of the Sewer Department from tax levy\$33,602.05".

Section 3. That the total appropriation for the City of LeRoy is hereby amended to read:

\$1,000,974.00
+33,602.05
\$1,034,576.05.

Section 4. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
