Note: The City of LeRoy requires liability insurance for any and all functions held in a city park or on city streets. Certificate of insurance must be provided at least 48 hours prior to the function.

REQUIREMENTS FOR USE OF PARKS AND PLAYGROUNDS

- 1. Pursuant to City Code 7-4-1, All parks in the City of Le Roy are closed from 10:00 p.m. to 6 a.m. with the exception of Howard Virgin Timber Park, where campers may camp overnight subsequent to completing the necessary permit and submitting required documentation and applicable Fee(s).
- 2. Camping Applications/Permit and Payment made to the City of Le Roy at Le Roy City Hall at the rate of \$5.00 per 24 hour period.
- 3. There is no charge for City of Le Roy Park reservations.
- 4. Fires are only allowed in locations with fire pits or grills. No fires are allowed on grass areas or parking areas.
- 5. Picnic tables and benches are to be kept under the pavilions. If tables are moved from the pavilions, they must be returned to the original location.
- 6. All tables must be wiped clean at the conclusion of the function.
- 7. Trash is to be placed in city-owned receptacles. Excess trash is the responsibility of the signer of this document, and must be removed from the premises.
- 8. City parks close at 10:00 p.m. Any function lasting past that hour must be approved by the mayor or city administrator.
- 9. No alcohol of any kind is permitted in city parks. A party violating this ordinance will be immediately dispersed by LeRoy Police Department, and tickets will be issued.
- 10. Areas of a park used for your function are to be kept clean, and any litter is to be picked up and placed in a trash receptacle. Bagged garbage cannot be left at the park site.
- 11. No overnight camping is allowed in city parks with the only exception being Howard Virgin Timber Park.
- 12. No vehicles are allowed on the meadow area at Howard Virgin Timber Park.
- 13. The City of LeRoy reserves the right to inspect premises during any function. Such inspections may be done by the police department, city administrator, or mayor.
- 14. Any damage to city property will result in an ordinance violation being written in the name of the person responsible for reserving the park.
