AN ORDINANCE LEVYING TAXES FOR CORPORATE PURPOSES FOR THE FISCAL YEAR COMMENCING ON THE FIRST DAY OF MAY, 2013 AND ENDING ON THE THIRTIETH DAY OF APRIL, 2014 FOR THE CITY OF LE ROY, McLEAN COUNTY, ILLINOIS.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Le Roy, Illinois as follows:

SECTION ONE: A property tax for the following sums of money, or as much thereof as may be authorized by law shall be levied to defray all expenses and liabilities of the City of Le Roy for the purposes specified against all taxable property in the City of Le Roy, Illinois, for the fiscal year commencing on the first day of May, 2013 and ending on the thirtieth day of April, 2014.
