AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 359, PROVIDING FOR A GRANT TO THE LeROY PROMOTION ASSOCIATION AND CHAMBER OF COMMERCE FOR A CITY CLEAN-UP BEAUTIFICATION PROJECT.

ORDINANCE NO. 366

WHEREAS, the City of LeRoy has, prior to the date of passage of this ordinance, enacted Ordinance No. 359, and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council find that it is necessary and desirable to provide assistance to the LeRoy Promotion Association and Chamber of Commerce (hereinafter referred to as LPA/C of C) in carrying out a clean-up and beautification project involving the central business district of the city,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the City Council of the City of LeRoy, Illinois, in lawful meeting assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Ordinance No. 359 is hereby amended by addition of the following words and figures as part of the first unnumbered paragraph, after the sub-item numbered 4:

The City of LeRoy hereby grants to the LPA/C OF C an additional amount not to exceed \$2,135.00 for the downtown restoration/ business district beautification project. Said grant shall be paid in increments upon proof of the incurring of material and labor expenses for such project being presented to the City Clerk. Said grant shall be paid from funds held under the First LeRoy Tax Increment Finance District or in the Redevelopment Fund, as may be permitted by law. The total of the grant may be less than \$2,135.00 if material and labor costs agreed to be paid by the City of LeRoy based on the written estimate submitted by the LPA/C of C at the May 21, 1990, LeRoy City Council meeting prove to be less than the estimated total deemed necessary.

Section 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect ten days after its passage and publication in pamphlet form as required by law.




