ORDINANCE NO. 16-05-02-50

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CITY'S LIQUOR CONTROL REGULATIONS REGARDING LICENSE CONDITIONS

WHEREAS, the City of Le Roy is an Illinois municipal corporation operating in accordance with the Illinois Municipal Code, 65 ILCS 5/1-1-1 et seq.; and

- WHEREAS, the Illinois Liquor Control Act grants the City the power to license the retail sale of alcoholic liquor, and "to establish such further regulations and restrictions upon the issuance of and operations under local licenses not inconsistent with law as the public good and convenience may require . . ." (235 ILCS 5/4-1); and
- WHEREAS, the Local Liquor Commissioner has the authority to suspend, revoke, reprimand, and fine licensees for permitting of any violation of state law or this code by any person upon the licensed premises (Code § 3-3-2); and
- WHEREAS, licensees are subject to noise control regulations in connection with the sale of alcoholic beverages in outdoor areas (Code § 3-3-17); and
- WHEREAS, the City desires to amend the City's liquor control regulations to expressly require all premises licensed for retail sales of alcoholic liquor to comply with all laws, including the City's general noise ordinances and regulations (Code §§ 4-1-4 (L); 5-2-6).
- **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Le Roy, McLean County, Illinois, as follows:
- **Section 1.** Recitals. The Council hereby finds that all of the recitals contained in the preambles to this Ordinance are full, true and correct and does incorporate them into this Ordinance by this reference.
- **Section 2.** <u>Amendment to Section 3-3-22.</u> Section 3-3-22 of the City of Le Roy Code of Ordinances, entitled "Prohibited Acts and Conditions," is hereby amended to add a new subsection (K), which shall read as follows:
 - K. Compliance with Laws. The maintenance and operation of the licensed premises must at all times comply with all applicable state, county and city statutes, ordinances, codes, rules, and regulations, including but not limited to all city noise ordinances and regulations, including sections 4-1-4 (L) and 5-2-6 of this code.
- **Section 3.** Conflict. All Ordinances and parts of Ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.
- **Section 4.** Effective Date. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect following its passage and approval as required by law.
