ORDINANCE NO. 605

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 34, LIQUOR, SECTION 34.17, SUB-SECTION B., AND SECTION 34.24, SUB-SECTIONS C. AND D., OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF LEROY, MCLEAN COUNTY, ILLINOIS, 1975 (as amended)

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council of the City of LeRoy, McLean County, Illinois, an Illinois municipal corporation, have determined that it is in the best interests of the City and its residents that the liquor control ordinances of the City be amended to permit the sales of package liquors by persons under the age of twenty-one (21), but not under the age of eighteen (18),

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of LeRoy, in lawful meeting assembled, as follows:

<u>Section 1</u>. Sub-section B. of <u>Section 34.17</u>, EMPLOYEES - DISEASES - AGE LIMITS., Municipal Code of the City of LeRoy, McLean County, Illinois, 1975 (as amended), is hereby repealed.

<u>Section 2.</u> New sub-section B. of <u>Section 34.17</u>, EMPLOYEES - DISEASES - AGE LIMITS, Municipal Code of the City of LeRoy, McLean County, Illinois 1975 (as amended), is hereby adopted in words and figures as follows:

B. It shall be illegal for any liquor licensee or for any officer, associate, member, representative, agent or employee of such licensee to employ upon any premises used for the sale of alcoholic beverages any person under twenty-one (21) years of age for the purpose of drawing, pouring or mixing alcoholic beverages for the consumption of such beverages upon said premises, or tending bar or to sell or consummate the sale of such beverages to be consumed on the licensed premises or sold or transferred in any form other than the original package. It shall be illegal for any liquor licensee or for any officer, associate, member, representative, agent or employee of such licensee to employ, upon any premises used for the sale of alcoholic beverages in the original package for consumption off the premises, any person under eighteen (18) years of age for the purpose of stocking shelves or displays, or for the purpose of selling or consummating the sale of any such beverages in their original package to be consumed off the licensed premises, such as but not limited to, sales at a package liquor store, grocery store, or convenience store, and only when any such stocking or sale is recorded on a surveillance-type camera surveying the area where the stocking, handling or sales may take place, the tape from such camera to be kept a minimum of forty-five (45) days after the completion of the stocking, handling or sale, such tapes to be available for review at any time upon the request of any member of the LeRoy Police Department or on request by or direction by the Liquor Control Commissioner of the City of LeRoy. It is the intention of the City Council in adopting this ordinance provision that any handling of liquor by a person under twenty-one (21) years of age, such liquor being intended for consumption upon the premises and not in its original container, is prohibited by any person under twenty-one (21) years of age, but that any person eighteen (18) years of age or older may handle alcoholic liquors

in the original package for purposes of moving the same upon the business premises, so long as the seal on the original package has not been broken, and so long as such movement or handling is solely for the purposes of stocking shelves, transporting alcoholic liquors in their original packages with seals unbroken from a stock room to another location on the premises, and the like.

<u>Section 3</u>. Sub-sections C. and D. of Section 34.24, Chapter 34, LIQUOR, Municipal Code of the City of LeRoy, Illinois, 1975 (as amended), are hereby repealed.

<u>Section 4</u>. New sub-sections C. and D. of Section 34.24, Chapter 34, LIQUOR, Municipal Code of the City of LeRoy, Illinois, 1975 (as amended), are hereby adopted in words and figures as follows:

- C. It shall be unlawful for any person to purchase or otherwise obtain alcoholic liquor and then to sell, give or deliver such alcoholic liquor to another person under the age of twenty-one (21) years, other than as previously provided herein in accordance with Section 34.17 B.
- D. It shall be illegal for any person to directly or indirectly have any alcoholic beverages sold, given or delivered to another person under twenty-one (21) years of age or to permit the sale, gift or delivery of any alcoholic beverage to another person under twenty-one (21) years of age, other than as previously provided herein in accordance with Section 34.17 B.

<u>Section 5</u>. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form, as required by law
