AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR AND APPROVING THE SALE OF PERSONAL PROPERTY OF THE CITY OF LE ROY, MC LEAN COUNTY, ILLINOIS

WHEREAS, the City of LeRoy, being a city organized under the laws of the State of Illinois and having less than 500,000 population, owns personal property which in the opinion of three-fourths of the corporate authorities now holding office is no longer necessary or useful to, or for, the best interests of said city; and

WHEREAS, property was disposed of as hereinafter described by unanimous consent of the corporate authorities of the City of LeRoy previous to the date of this ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of LeRoy, Illinois, in lawful meeting assembled:

Instructions

(Reference - C.24, III.Rev.Stat., Sec. 11-76-4)
(Date of these instructions: 1-16-90, Statutes searched through effective date of P.A. 86-950, November 20, 1989)

- 1. A city or village incorporated under the laws of the State of Illinois of less than 500,000 population, when wishing to dispose of personal property which in the opinion of 3/4 of the corporate authorities then holding office is no longer necessary, useful to or for the best interest of the city or village, may: (a) by ordinance authorize the sale of that personal property in such manner as they may designate, with or without advertising the sale, (b) authorize any municipal officer to convert that personal property into some other form that is useful to the city or village by using the material in the personal property, (c) authorize any municipal officer to convey or turn in any specified article of personal property as part payment on a new purchase of any similar article.
- 2. An ordinance should be adopted if the item is to be sold.
- 3. If the article is to be turned in as part of the purchase price on any purchase of new or replacement items, the trade-in is only allowed in a situation where competitive bids are solicited for to purchase the new item.
- 4. Notice to all bidders must include the fact that the article will be turned over or traded in as part of the purchase price.
- 5. Attached is a master copy of an ordinance suitable for use in disposing of personal property from time to time by the City of LeRoy, including a cover sheet, and necessary certificates at the end for publication in pamphlet form when appropriate, and a certification as to copies of the ordinance.
- 6. NOTE: 3/4 of the corporate authorities then holding office must vote in favor of the ordinance to dispose of the property in whatever manner set forth in the ordinance.
