INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN EMPIRE TOWNSHIP ROAD DISTRICT AND CITY OF LEROY

This Intergovernmental Agreement (referred to as the "Agreement") is entered into this 16th day of January, 2012, between Empire Township Road District, (hereinafter "R.D.") with office at 610 W. Center, LeRoy, and the City of LeRoy, (hereinafter "City"), with an office at 207 S. East Street, LeRoy, in the County of McLean and State of Illinois.

RECITALS

WHEREAS, the R.D. and City are public agencies within the meaning of the Illinois Intergovernmental Cooperation Act, 5 ILCS 220/1 et.seq. as authorized by Article VII, Section 10 of the 1970 Constitution of the State of Illinois. The Illinois Constitution and the Illinois Statutes encourage and provide for units of local government to cooperate and to enter into Intergovernmental Agreements in any manner not prohibited by law or ordinance, to their mutual benefit; and

WHEREAS, the R.D. and City own various and different types of heavy mechanical equipment included but not limited to trucks, trailers, tractors, grades, and other types of maintenance equipment; and

WHEREAS, it is not economically feasible for the R.D. and City to purchase and maintain all types of heavy machinery and equipment separately; and

WHEREAS, the sharing of this equipment by and between the R.D. and City makes the best use of the limited financial resources of the R.D. and City, it would be in the best interests of the residents of the R.D. and City.

NOW THEREFORE, the R.D. and City agree to share their machinery equipment, and labor with each other under the following terms and conditions:

- 1. The R.D. and City may borrow equipment owned by the R.D. or City if the equipment is not being used or scheduled for immediate use by the R.D. or City;
- 2. The borrowing R.D. and City shall return the equipment or machinery in substantially the same condition as when it was lent, with reasonable wear and tear expected. For example, if there is an anti-freeze leak and the operator stops and it gets fixed, that is the cost of the owner, (reasonable wear and tear) but if the operator does not stop and the engine blows due to neglect then it

- is the cost of the operator's employer. This will also cover any accidents that the insurance company may not pay;
- 3. The user, R.D. or City shall be responsible for providing fuel and routine operating and preventative maintenance for the equipment;
- 4. The City Public Works Director and R.D. Commissioner must agree on the person to be operating the equipment;
- 5. The operator of the equipment must have all legally required licenses and/or certification before operating any equipment;
- 6. Insurance shall be obtained and maintained by the City or R.D. owning the equipment or machinery. The R.D. and City insurance carriers shall be informed of the terms of this Agreement. A certificate of coverage shall be provided to both R.D. and City for each other's equipment showing the non-owner as an insured under the policy;
- 7. The term of this Agreement shall be from January 16, 2012, to the 15th day of January 2013. The Agreement may be extended or modified to include additional terms and provisions by further written agreement from both parties at any time; and
- 8. Either party may terminate this Agreement at any time by providing a written notice to the other party.

The laws of the State of Illinois will govern THIS AGREEMENT interpretation and performance.
