AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE SIX – MOTOR VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC; CHAPTER TWO – TRAFFIC REGULATIONS; SECTION FIVE TRAFFIC REGULATIONS ON SPECIFIC STREETS OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF LE ROY, 2003 (AS AMENDED)

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council of the City of Le Roy, McLean County, Illinois, an Illinois municipal corporation, have determined that the intersections hereinafter described, located within the City of Le Roy, Illinois, are appropriate to be controlled by stop and yield signs at said intersections; and

WHEREAS, the City of Le Roy, by ordinance, may provide for the erection of stop and yield signs to control a street intersection

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the City Council of the City of Le Roy, Illinois, in lawful meeting assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Motor Vehicles and Traffic, Traffic Regulations, Traffic Regulations on Specific Streets of the Municipal Code of the City of Le Roy, Illinois, 2003(as amended), is hereby amended in words and figures as follows:

Section 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as required by law.

SCHEDULE E

STOP SIGNS

FOUR WAY STOPS

- (a) The following intersections are declared to be all-way stops, and all vehicles must come to a complete stop before proceeding into or across intersections:
 - 1. East Washington Street and North Chestnut Street.
- (b) All vehicles traveling upon the above named streets must come to a complete stop before proceeding into or across the named intersections.

THREE-WAY STOPS

 South East Street and East Pine Street- Stop signs are northbound/ southbound on South East Street and westbound on East Pine Street.

ONE-WAY STOP

East Pine Street at South Chestnut Street - stop sign is on eastbound Pine
 Street/South Chestnut Street is the thru-street

TWO WAY YIELDS

- East Elm Street at North Pearl Street Yield signs are on East Elm
 Street/North Pearl is the thru-street.
- 2. North Main Street at Green Street Yield signs are on Green Street/North Main is the thru-street.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval as required by law.
