## ORDINANCE NO. 292

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 21, ZONING, SECTION 21.03 (f) and (h), PERMITTED OBSTRUCTIONS IN REQUIRED YARDS, MUNICIPAL CODE OF LEROY, ILLINOIS, 1975 (AS AMENDED).

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council of the City of LeRoy, McLean County, Illinois, an Illinois municipal corporation (hereinafter referred to as "CITY"), are aware that television and radio antennas are being used more and more by individual homeowners and, to some extent, businesses and other commercial establishments; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the City to permit the use by property owners of their property subject to reasonable regulations, and to protect the right of other property owners; and

WHEREAS, the City is aware of its duties to protect the health, safety and welfare of all the residents of the City of LeRoy, McLean County, Illinois,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of LeRoy, Illinois, in lawful meeting assembled, as follows:

Section 1. That Section 21.03(f), Accessory Buildings, Structures and Uses, of Chapter 21, ZONING, Municipal Code of LeRoy, Illinois, 1975 (as amended), is hereby further amended by deletion and repeal of the existing sub-sub-section 4., and adoption of a new sub-sub-section 4., in words and figures as follows:

4. An Accessory Building, Structure, or Use (including television and radio antenna) may be erected as an integral part of the principal building, or, if at least six feet therefrom, may be connected thereto by a breeze-way or similar structure, provided all yard requirements of this Ordinance for a principal structure are complied with, unless such accessory building (including television and radio antenna) is in a rear yard, in which case, sub-section (f)2. shall be applicable.

Section 2. That Section 21.03(h), Permitted Obstructions in Required Yards, of Chapter 21, ZONING, Municipal Code of LeRoy, Illinois, 1975 (as amended), is hereby further amended by addition of language to sub-sub-

section 4., by addition of the words "television and radio antennas (meeting all height limitations in any given zoning district);" said additional language to be included after the semicolon after the word "porches" and before the word "open" after the semicolon in the second line of said sub-sub-section.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as required by law.
