

ORDINANCE NO. 104

WHEREAS, a Petition to rezone the following described real estate:

Lot 5, Block 26, Original Town

seeks to rezone said premises from a Classification of R-2, General Residential to C-2, Highway Commercial, and

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held by the Zoning Board of Appeals of the City of LeRoy, Illinois on Monday, August 20, 1979 at 8 P.M. in the City Hall, in accordance with law to consider said Petition, and

WHEREAS, said Zoning Board of Appeals did recommend to the City Council of the City of Le Roy, Illinois approval of said Petition for change of zoning classification of the above described premises, and

WHEREAS, all things required by law to be done in and about the re-zoning of said property have been completed:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Le Roy, Illinois as follows,

The Zoning Ordinance for the City of Le Roy, Illinois which was adopted on the 16th day of June, 1975, as amended, is amended by amending the Zoning Map adopted as part of said Zoning Ordinance, to provide that the premises described above shall henceforth be zoned Highway Commercial.
