RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE ILLINOIS DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES AND OTHER STATE AGENCIES SEEK OWNERSHIP OF THE NORFOLK AND SOUTHERN RAILROAD RIGHT OF WAY FROM NEAR MANSFIELD TO NEAR BLOOMINGTON

WHEREAS, the Norfolk and Southern Railroad Company has initiated actions which will likely lead to the abandonment and removal of rails from near Mansfield to near Bloomington;

WHEREAS, the Norfolk and Southern Railroad Company right of way has many useful purposes which would benefit the residents of Illinois and particularly the residents of the communities of Mansfield, Farmer City, Le Roy, Downs and Bloomington and the counties of Piatt, DeWitt, and McLean;

WHEREAS, the United States government has established the Federal Rail Bank Act to reserve railroad right of ways for public use;

WHEREAS, the Illinois Department of Natural Resources in cooperation with other state departments and agencies has the resources to negotiate for the rights and ownership of the right of way; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LE ROY, McLEAN COUNTY, ILLINOIS:

FIRST: that the City of Le Roy finds the Norfolk and Southern Railroad Company right of way has many useful purposes which would benefit the residents of Illinois and particularly the residents of the communities of Mansfield, Farmer City, Le Roy, Downs and Bloomington and the counties of Piatt, DeWitt and McLean; and

SECOND: that since the United States government has established the Federal Rail Bank Act to reserve railroad right of ways for public use it should be used to preserve the Norfolk and Southern Railroad rights of way; and

THIRD: that since the Illinois Department of Natural Resources in cooperation with other state departments and agencies has the resources to negotiate for the rights and ownership of the right of way a request be submitted jointly with neighboring communities and counties to request state participation; and

FOURTH: that copies of this resolution be submitted to Governor George H. Ryan, and all local state representatives; and

FIFTH: that copies of this resolution be submitted to the clerks of each community and counties which would benefit from the preservation of the Norfolk and Southern right of way.
