## ANNUAL APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE NO. 1/9 FOR THE CITY OF LE ROY, ILLINOIS 1980 - 1981

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LE ROY, MC LEAN COUNTY, ILLINOIS:
