RESOLUTION NO. 18-03-04-90

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING A CITY POLICY REGARDING THE DELIVERY OF WHITE ROCK

WHEREAS, the City of LeRoy has received requests from residents of the City for the delivery of white rock to residential property owners for the purpose of improving the road right-of-way, parking area located between the property line and the traveled and improved portion of the adjacent roadway; and

WHEREAS, the City of LeRoy has in the past sold white rock to resident desiring to spread such white rock on City right-of-way adjacent to their property for the purpose of improving parking areas; and

WHEREAS, the sale of white rock necessitates the collection of sales tax by the City and payment of sales tax by property owners receiving said white rock; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to implement a Cost Sharing Program for the delivery of white rock, where City residents pay the cost of labor costs in delivering said rock, rather than purchasing said rock; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of LeRoy to establish a Cost Sharing Program for the delivery of white rock to residents for use in improving on-street parking areas adjacent to residential property.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE City Council for the City of Le Roy, McLean County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1. That the City Administrator be and he is hereby authorized and directed to establish a Cost Sharing Program for residents who desire to improve the roadway parking areas adjacent to their property within the City of LeRoy. The Cost Sharing Program shall include payment to the City of a flat hourly rate as determined by the City Administrator in order to reimburse the City the costs of compensation for employees gathering and delivering said rock, the use of City equipment for transportation purposes, administrative costs, insurance, payroll taxes and employee benefits.

SECTION 2. Residents desiring to participate in said program may make application to the City and provide payment in the amount as determined appropriate by the City Administrator. Such participation shall be documented in a form determined appropriate by the City Administrator.

SECTION 3. Participation in the white rock Cost Sharing Program shall be voluntary on the part of residents and available in the discretion of the City Administrator based on the availability of City resources and man power.

SECTION 4. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval as provided by law.
