



SPECIAL PROJECTS COMMITTEE MEETING HELD MARCH 5, 2018

Meeting was called to order at 6:00 PM at Le Roy City Hall, 207 S. East Street with council members Dawn Hanafin, Rick Kline, Kyle Merkle, Brad Poindexter, Glenn Reinhart, Ron Legner, Hilary Neal and Greg Steffen present. Also present was City Administrator Dave Jenkins, Clerk Vicki Moreland, Dean Buhrke, and Chief Williamson.

The meeting was called to discuss the 2018-2019 FY Budget. The changes from the last budget meeting in the General fund budget were discussed. Also, MFT will not be used for street repair the coming budget year to give that fund a chance to recover.

Dean spoke on the plans for expenditures for the Street department. There are culverts that need replaced or dug out. Pearl Street between Green and Wayne will need to be rebuilt as well as High Street between Cedar and Pine. He also plans to cut shoulders and ditches in certain areas as well as repair the concrete ditch by the tennis courts. The Street department employees will help with the construction of the new salt shed as well as the repair of the roof on the old one. A contractor is lined up to seal coat and City employees will sweep the streets, cover manholes and water shut-offs as well as traffic control and re-striping to save on the cost.

Chief Williamson stated that the Capital Projects line item was reduced due to the grant money that was to go towards the postponed K-9 instead being used towards the new squad purchase. He also stated that the K-9 vehicle would be re-fitted back to a full service squad making it more useful.

The meeting was adjourned at 6:55 PM.
