

**ORDINANCE NO. 17-03-01-40**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CITY CODE PROVISIONS RELATING TO LANDFILL  
CLOSURE FEES AND REFUSE COLLECTION SERVICE FEES**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Le Roy is an Illinois municipal corporation operating in accordance with the Illinois Municipal Code, 65 ILCS 5/1-1-1 et seq.; and

**WHEREAS**, the City previously operated a municipal landfill, which has since been closed; and

**WHEREAS**, in order to finalize the closure of the landfill, the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency requires the City to pay for an ongoing monitoring program, which includes ongoing chemical and engineering evaluations; and

**WHEREAS**, the City desires to reduce the landfill fee to reflect the actual costs incurred in relation to the closure of the landfill; and

**WHEREAS**, the City provides refuse collection services to all City residents, which requires the City to incur substantial costs; and

**WHEREAS**, in order to continue to provide the same level of refuse collection services to City residents, a refuse collection service fee must be imposed; and

**WHEREAS**, in furtherance of the City's obligation to finalize the closure of the landfill and to provide refuse collection services, the City desires to amend the City Code provisions relating to landfill closure fees and refuse collection service fees as set forth in this Ordinance.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Le Roy, McLean County, Illinois, as follows:

**Section 1. Recitals.** The above-referenced recitals are hereby incorporated into this Ordinance by this reference.

**Section 2. Amendment to Section 4-2-3.** Section 4-2-3 of the City of Le Roy Code of Ordinances, titled "Landfill Closure," is hereby amended as follows:

**4-2-3: LANDFILL CLOSURE**

~~A. Closure Requirements: The anticipated expense to close the landfill will include the following Illinois environmental protection agency mandates: 1) an ongoing monitoring program that will cost approximately forty five thousand dollars (\$45,000.00) per year; 2) ongoing chemical evaluation that will cost an estimated fifty five thousand dollars (\$55,000.00) per year; 3) engineering and ongoing mandated responsibilities, approximately thirty nine thousand dollars (\$39,000.00) per year.~~

**A. Landfill Fee: All utility customers of the City of Le Roy shall will continue to pay a three dollar (\$3.00) Landfill Fee an eight dollar (\$38.00) per month fee beginning**

with the first bill payable in prepared after ~~May 4, 2017~~, and continuing until for ~~sixty (60) consecutive months, May 24, 2020.~~ ~~4, 2018.~~

**Section 3. Amendment to Section 4-2-2-4.** Section 4-2-2-4 of the City of Le Roy Code of Ordinances, titled "Rates," is hereby amended to add a new Subsection (A)(4), entitled "Service Fee," as follows:

4. **Service Fee.** All refuse collection customers will be required to pay a service fee of five dollars (\$5.00) per month beginning with the first bill payable in prepared after ~~May, 2017.~~

**Section 4. Conflict.** All Ordinances and parts of Ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

**Section 5. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect beginning on March 6, 2017.


